How to Maintain a Stone Resin Bathtub and Basin?

Routine Care

The best thing about Solid Surface products is they need very little maintenance once in a while and you don't need professionals to do it. Keep your bathware dry to avoid rusting. You can remove stains using usual household cleansing agents like soaps and dish washing liquid.

Caution

Do not use chemical products with high alkaline products with Solid Surface products because they can damage the glossy surface. The same goes for Ammonia based cleansing agents.



How to remove scratches and fix damaged parts?

Matte and glossy surfaces are different and that's why they have different methods of dealing with scratches and damaged parts.

1) Matte surface



Sand paper can easily remove most of the scratches and you can do it yourself. After using sand paper, rinse water and let the product dry. We provide sand paper with Solid Surface Bathtubs and for other products you can easily buy it from your local store.

2) Glossy surface

Removing scratches from Glossy Surface may need some creative ideas because you'd want to damage the shine of the product. For small scratches, you can use toothpaste and scrub it on the damaged area. Or you can use a sand paper with high grit like 3M 2000 Grit to remove scratches.

To restore the gloss, you need to wax the damaged area. You can use car polish or wool pad to restore that part. However, this step is usually done by professionals.
